## Mile 26.2 Trail MP 25.2 Over McPherson Creek, East of National Tunnel

No construction dates evident – but probably built 1913 during Montour expansion.

Bridge over small stream is not really noticeable from the Right-of-Way. It is in the center of this picture, which is looking west toward National Tunnel.
