MP 27.5 8' Concrete Slab

Mile 26.4 Trail MP 25.4 Over McPherson Creek, East of National Tunnel

No construction dates evident – but probably built 1913 during Montour expansion.

Bridge over small stream is not really noticeable from Right-of-Way, except for split rail fence on either side. This view is of south side of bridge.
