

## Montour Junction Shops Loop Track    Approx 75' Deck Plate Girder Over Montour Run

Carried loop track from P&LE main to Shops and over Montour Run – Bridge Removed

This 1946 aerial view shows the loop track bridge as the lower of the 3 bridges. Steam locomotives are sitting in front of the shops.

This map ca. 1905 shows three bridges over Montour Run in front of the Shops. The Shop Loop was to the right, used by the P&LE to deliver cars to the Montour.

By 1957, the loop track next to the Montour Shops and its bridge have been removed. The Groveton Loop, seen at the lower right, and its bridge were built in 1934 to replace the Shop Loop and was a delivery point for empty hopper cars from the P&LE.
